Objectives of spending the funding 2015-2016

- To replace any PE equipment and resources which have been lost or damaged over time.
- To use some of our money to pay for after school coaches to give the children a varied and rich PE experience.
- To pay for a TA to help with the general running of PE such as by sorting clubs and the cupboards / resources and to give time for the PE Co-ordinator to analyse the planning and PE progress the children are making.
- To provide funding for a gifted and talented child to be able to attend their gymnastics club.
