<p>Children will Investigate how flying and aeroplanes have changed over time and create a simple timeline of changes in flying.</p> <p>Children will find out about how The Wright Brothers designed their aeroplane. They will produce a drawing of a plane, using images of the Wright Brothers' plane.</p> <p>Children will learn about the first balloon flight- The Montgolfier brothers. They will design a hot air balloon.</p>	<p>Children will map Amelia Earhart's route and guide her plane across a simple grid.</p> <p>They will visit certain landmarks/ targets along the way using N, S, E, W and count the number of units to move.</p> <p>Children will locate on a map where Amelia Earhart was from and where she flew.</p>	<p>Children will design and build a small plane. They will compare materials and their properties and suitability to the task. They will have the opportunity to fly their planes (OL).</p> <p>After designing and making their planes. During the test flight, the children will measure the distance flown/ moved by the small plane. They will compare the models in size and weight and record distances flown in bar charts (OL).</p>
