Key facts:

Jews, Christians and Muslims believe that there is a Creator of the world, God. In the Bible the story of Genesis tells Christians how the world was made.

The Earth and everything in it are important to God.

God has a unique relationship with human beings as their Creator.

Humans should care for the world because it belongs to God.

Believing that the world belongs to God, and that God gives life, can affect how a Christian lives — being thankful, grateful, looking after God's world.



When Christians pray they thank God for creating the world.

They also thank God for the food they eat as well as for their family and friends and health.

One way to show thankfulness is through the annual celebration of Harvest. Saying 'grace' at meal times is a more regular part of life for many Christian families — it reminds them to be thankful to God for all the good things, even the simplest things like food and drink.
