<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Read The Three Little Pigs - make predictions as to what will happen next in the story • Can we make up our own stories using The Three Little Pigs as inspiration? • Read All Are Welcome (talk about our differences and similarities but that we are all friends in Nursery). Promoting tolerance (BV) and also (SD). • Forest - using the natural resources to re-enact The Three Little Pigs story (OL) • Voting for our class story - building up our Poetry basket (Children having 5 rich language experiences throughout the day) - BV • Awe and wonder outside looking at changes in the weather and the impact on the natural world - frozen spider webs, etc. (SD, OL) • Thinking about superheroes (imaginary and real life), their qualities and how they help us • Role play to talk about being kind - sharing toys. (SD) Talk about love and how to be a good friend. Link to being the best you can be. • Poetry basket - spring poems.
